

The Lord's Prayer PATTERN

^{NAU} **Matthew 6:9-13** "Pray, then, in this way: 'Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. 'Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven. 'Give us this day our daily bread. 'And forgive us our *sins*, as we also forgive those who sin against us. 'And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from [the] evil [one]. *For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.*'

- ◆ **Intimacy** *Our Father*
- ◆ **Praise & Worship** *Hallowed be Your name* (to make your name holy)
- ◆ **Purpose / priority** *Your kingdom come.* Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven
- ◆ **Provision** *Give us this day our daily bread*
- ◆ **Pardon / confession, forgiveness** *And forgive us our sins, as we also forgive those who sin against us*
- ◆ **Protection / guidance** *do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from [the] evil [one]*
- ◆ **People** *Our ...us ...us our ... we ... our ... us ... us* – THE Kingdom-others
- ◆ **Humility** *YOURS is the Kingdom—it's your power, it's your glory—IT'S ALL ABOUT YOU*

The A.C.T.S. PATTERN

(C.A.T.S.)

- ◆ **Adoration** is to adore God, to worship him and to fulfill the commandment to love him with all of our heart, mind and soul. As we spend time in adoration, we praise God for who He is - our Creator, our Sustainer and our Redeemer.
- ◆ **Confession** *"If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."* (1 Jn 1:8,9)
- ◆ **Thanksgiving** *"I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone— for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness."* (1 Tim 2:1)
- ◆ **Supplication or Intercession** -- needs
 - needs of others
 - needs of the world
 - our own needs
